

SEX OFFENDER CHECK LIST:

- 1.) Do register with local law enforcement within 72 hours of your release.
- 2.) Prepare for a residency check within 24 hours of your release.
- 3.) Make certain there are no alcoholic beverages/drugs/drug paraphernalia on premises.
- 4.) Make certain anyone who visits you while you are on parole is advised that you are not allowed any alcoholic beverages/drugs/drug paraphernalia on premises.
- 5.) Make certain there are no photographs of young people under the age of 18 – even if they are siblings. If your girlfriend or wife visits, make certain she has no pictures of children in her wallet.
- 6.) Make certain there is no pornography on premises – Playboy, Hustler, etc.
- 7.) Make certain there are no collectibles in your living area – for example, someone might collect dolls or Disney figurines. Have them put away.
- 8.) If you have a cell phone - no camera , text or internet capability.
- 9.) Do attend counseling sessions.
- 10.) Seek employment.
- 11.) Each time employment changes or you acquire a new vehicle; you MUST re-register with your local law enforcement agency.
- 12.) Places to stay away from include: schools, churches with schools, carnivals, parks . The best bet is to stay away from places where children gather.
- 13.) No computer or internet connection allowed.
- 14.) Holidays: **Halloween** – no decorations and no trick or treating is allowed where you reside. DO NOT ANSWER THE DOOR. Prepare for a visit from your P.O. or, at times, they send you somewhere to lay low for the day. **Christmas** – cannot be spent with children under the age of 18. Expect a visit either Christmas Eve or Christmas Day for a check. **Easter**: No decorations. No children under the age of 18.
- 15.) **REMEMBER**: If they elect to do a search, they can only search the areas where you reside. They **CANNOT** search someone else's bedroom such as a family member
- 16.) Plan for drug and alcohol screens at their discretion.
